The Apex DPX is first and foremost a BASE rig. It can be used for the day to day BASE jumps, but it can also be used in ways that no other rig can.



The Apex DPX incorporates the same Dual Pin design as the popular Apex DP. The pin protector flap slips into the top flap and has an easy release important on low airspeed jumps.



The Apex DPX has riser covers that tuck on the inboard side and a BOC for the pilot chute.

...but there's more.



When the time comes and you feel the need to get into the backcountry, the Apex DPX will be there for you. Load up the back pack with the backcountry essentials and hit the trail.



Regardless if the hike takes place before or after the jump, in some locations both, you can be ready with backpacking standard items.



Once the items are unpacked you can have a home away from home. Pictured items include down sleeping bag, Thermarest sleeping pad, climbing harness, 9mm rope, water purification system, water proof bags, beanie and gloves, a back pack, and more.



With the Apex DPX you can bring along just about anything to make your adventure more enjoyable. Whether it include a tent, a bottle of wine and girlfriend (she will need her own rig) or more climbing gear or camera equipment– the versatility of the Apex DPX is endless.



For the jump everything can be placed in the, top loading, Storage Cell and jumped off. Shown is the 1300 cubic inch Storage Cell (also available in a 3300 cubic inch).



One of the many unique features of the Apex DPX is the two BOC pockets. During the standard BASE rig mode a typical BOC is used, but once the Storage Cell is eXpanded the second BOC (located on the bottom of the storage cell) is used, thus keeping the handle in the same relative location for the jumper.



After landing everything can be packed into the back pack and hiked out.



Or, if the location requires, camp can be set up for the evening.



Converting between the BASE rig mode and the eXpanded mode is accomplished using a single yellow cable and loops (similar to wing suits).

Typically starting at the bottom align loops, weave the cable and pull taught. The two ends of the cable finish at the top and stow away.

The cable keeps the Storage Cell closed during BASE rig mode but when eXpanded the cable (and any other small items) can be stored in the Storage Cell lid.

Now it is ready for the next load at the local object or within minutes it can be ready for whatever adventure you have in mind.

The Apex DPX is fully functional in several different configurations.

The Apex DPX features include:

- 1450 (1300) cubic inch Storage Cell
- Internal riser cover
- Two BOC pockets

- 3700 (3300) cubic inch Storage Cell
- Saddle Bags
- Articulated Harness
